Urgent Work

We have successfully completed the work on the outside of the tower at a cost of £38,000 – **Phase I**

We have now received a grant from English Heritage of £110,000 for work on the roofs estimated to cost £143,000 – **Phase II**

To complete this phase of the work we urgently require £38,000 by Autumn 2003

Roof restoration	£143,000
Contingencies	£5,000
Total	£148,000
